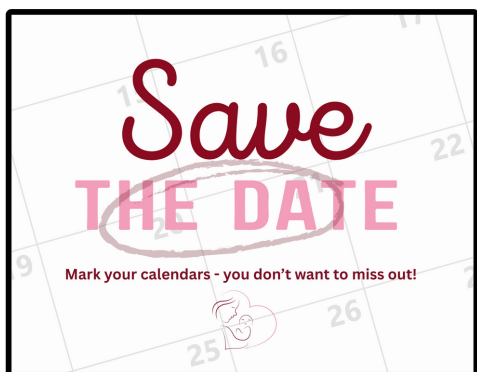

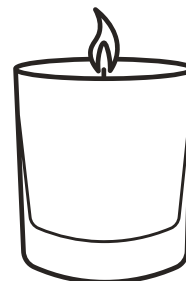

We got to spend time with all of the Pulse Staff and Purity Presenters. Then we got to spend time with Pastor Pikki and his family in the Gypsy community. So many wonderful things happening in Romania.

The Purity Presenters have recently connected to a school within a Gypsy community outside of Oradea which has provided much needed education to the teens in the community. Poverty, human trafficking, and teen pregnancy are just some of the concerns the staff are trying to tackle. Be praying for them as they share and minister to this community.

The Medical Clinic in Boldesti-Scaeni continues to offer blood draws once a week but we are excited to work more closely with My Brother's Keeper to expand services offered within the clinic. More to come on this!
